



## Many Steps to reach the Archway!

- Initially, a google survey with conceptual ideas was taken-images and wording
- Then reached out to local fabricators/ironworkers
- As artists reached out to us, we changed our process=Equitable
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) was drafted and published in Jan 2020.
  - Reached out to previous vendors/ironworkers
- Ended up with 2 finalists.
- Upon receiving CCG Awards, selected Brad Kessler

- Horizontal construction not due to begin until 2022.
- Vertical construction not due to start till 2023.


### **Balboa Reservoir Community Advisory Committee**

### **Developer timeline**


- This year: Design and mapping; choosing a developer for the Town House section; community design meeting.
