
Project Focus

The Frida Kahlo Way Quick-Build Project aims to improve the safety and accessibility of the Frida Kahlo Way and Judson Ave corridors for people walking, bicycling, and taking transit. The project will add a two-way protected bikeway, upgrade transit stops and crosswalks, and revise travel lanes and curb parking and loading areas.

These changes will better connect the Sunnyside and Ingleside neighborhoods, Ocean Avenue commercial corridor, City College and other area schools, and the planned Balboa Reservoir development to each other and with nearby Muni and BART services. Public feedback will help shape the final proposal that could be constructed in 2024, if approved.

A two-way protected bikeway on the east side of Frida Kahlo Way and south side of Judson Ave to physically separate people riding bikes from people driving. The bikeway will replace existing parking on the east side of Frida Kahlo Way but vehicle travel lanes will be unaffected. Click here to learn more about protected bikeways.

Bus boarding islands provide level, in-roadway boarding for people riding the 43 bus line to improve reliability and access for all riders.

Bus stop relocation and consolidation improves Muni reliability and better locates bus zones for safe access by Riordan High and City College students.
